We The People Program 28 Bureaucracy



I have a growing concern that this country and indeed much of the free world has a massive problem within government and that's the bureaucracy. It's the term used to describe a system of governance where a hierarchy is formed around clusters of competency, impersonal rules, fixed salaries and no public accountability. There is nothing inherently wrong with a bureaucratic structure except for the failings of people who then use it to concentrate power and authority. Freedom of information is simply not available to us and this is happening far too frequently and the lack of transparency is breathtaking. The sign of a ship in trouble is when it begins to leak and the same is true of Council as the leaks flood out all kinds of information and whistle blowers. I've just seen a highly confidential Queensland Treasury document which further exposes the horrendous waste in the Council and the fact that the Councillors have been kept silent because of the restrictions on the document. I don't imagine for a moment they care as it probably suits them but it does expose some very worrying issues and more on that revelation very soon.

The Gold Coast City Council regularly prints and sends out a news letter full of self righteous propaganda about itself. The last expensive edition featured the then mayor Ron Clark on the front cover saying that there had never been a better time financially for the Gold Coast. I called his office and asked to speak to him on two occasions as to the basis of this public claim. The Mayor didn't return the phone calls and it appears to me that under his leadership the Gold Coast has suffered badly in terms of direction and governance. This new leaked document and the recent demise of our credit rating shows clearly he was not being wholly truthful with us.

We've just witnessed Queensland voters demanding a new deal at State government level and friends, we must do the same at local level as well and simply get rid of the entrenched councillors and restore transparent open local government. Without transparency we're at the mercy of the bureaucracy which is almighty and powerful at the moment. Shortly some very alarming facts will be exposed along with secret plans to massively increase rates and the exisiting councillors know this and their silence is reprehensible.
