Good Day to you. The year 1770 was an important year when Captain Cook discovered Australia's eastern coast line. During his astonishing and courageous voyage he followed the coast of then Terra Australis from south to north mapping and naming dominant geographic features and places. It must have been amazing for the Englishman to see such an ancient land and its pristine waterways and unique wildlife and vegetation. I think we should be grateful the English settled here and not some other mob who may well have dominated with a dictatorship or cruel autocracy.
